2. I am thus able to confirm the following commitments, which ensue from my membership of a club, team or crew affiliated to a DBO, which is itself a member of the IDBF and from my participation in IDBF activities, notably World Championships, international regattas, or other events which are organised under the authority of the IDBF or one of its Continental or Regional Federations, such as the Asian Dragon Boat Federation (ADBF) or European Dragon Boat Federation (EDBF). I therefore recognise and accept the authority of the IDBF, as the sole governing body for the sport, on all matters concerning Dragon Boat Sport.

3. I also recognise and accept:-

a. The mandatory character of the Statutes, the Bye-laws, the Competition Regulations, the Rules of Racing and other rules regulating the IDBF, in their current version and ***as amended from time to time, and I agree to uphold and abide by them without reservation.***

b. The obligation to respect fundamental ethical principles and to act within the implicit nature and intent of IDBF legislation, that is, to always compete/ participate honourably and uphold the principles of good sportsmanship, fair play and non-discrimination and to behave, in all circumstances, in an appropriate manner.

4. I understand that any personal behaviour that could result in action being taken under the IDBF Disciplinary Code, is deemed to be NOT appropriate. I declare in particular: that I do not use and that I will not use as long as I compete, substances or methods which are prohibited by the IDBF Anti-Doping rules and that:-

1. I am aware of the fight against doping which IDBF supports alongside others and, in particular, the conducting of out-of-competition anti-doping tests and that severe doping violations in dragon boating can be punished with a life ban.





2. I am willing to submit to any tests (blood, urine, gas, etc) carried out by the IDBF and to inform my team doctor of all the medication that I take.
